

School Dress Code

NMESC Shirt

Year 7 – 9

- School shirt (blue) or light blue polo shirt
- No singlets, black shirts or grey shirts
- If a student is wearing a shirt under their polo shirt it can be white or light blue

Year 10 – 12

- School shirt (white) or white polo shirt
- No singlets, black shirts or white shirts
- If the student is wearing a shirt under their polo shirt it can be white

NMESC Jumper

- School jumper (or rugby top)
- School jacket (including leavers' and country week jackets)
- School track top
- Light blue or white jumper
- No black or grey jumpers
- No logos or hooded garments

NMESC Pants

- Black pants, shorts or skirts
- School track pants or shorts
- Shorts and skirts must be $\frac{3}{4}$ length
- No denim

NMESC Physical Education

- Students may have a change of clothes (shorts/track pants and plain top) for Physical Education. A Physical Education t-shirt is available from the uniform shop and is only to be worn for Physical Education.
